## OUTLINES OF THE PROGRAMS

### ◆ **Continents Design Education Program/CODE Program**

The program is provided in collaboration with universities in three areas: Japan, the United States and Europe with distinctive design educational program. The goal of this program is to nurture global designers who potentially take big roles in creative industries, particularly service industry and contents industry by recruiting excellent students from all over the world. By this, the program ultimately encourages the creation of new Japanese industries in the future.

The program is run in collaboration with the following twelve universities in the United States and European universities: Glasgow School of Art (U.K.), TH Köln-Technische Hochschule Köln (Germany), École Nationale Supérieure de Création Industrielle, ENSCI (France), Strate School of Design (France), L'École de Design Nantes Atlantique (France), Politecnico di Milano (Italy), ISIA Roma Design (Italy), The New School (U.S.), College for Creative Studies (U.S.), University of Cincinnati (U.S.), Aalto University School of Arts, Design and Architecture (Finland) and IADE-U Instituto de Arte, Design e Empresa-Universitário (Portugal). Excellent students from these universities are welcomed to Chiba University to enroll in the master's degree program. The program consists of two types: the program that grants only Chiba University's degree, and the double degree program that grants both Chiba and your own university's degree that is available in some of the universities. For students who wish to enroll in the latter, please apply for the Double Degree Program Special Selection.

### ◆ **Master of Asia Design Education Program/MADE Program**

This program is to address the expanding field of industrial design, and offers educational research in Asia centering on service design and engineering design. The program is jointly run by Chiba University and ten major Asian universities: Seoul National University (Korea), Yonsei University (Korea), Tsinghua University (China), Zhejiang University (China), Dalian University of Technology (China), China Academy of Art (China), Nanjing University of the Arts (China), Guangzhou Academy of Fine Arts (China), Nanyang Technological University (Singapore) and Institut Teknologi Bandung (Indonesia). Students of particular excellence will be invited to Chiba University to study for a master's degree. The program consists of the Double Degree Program, where students will obtain a degree each from the two universities, and the Degree Program where students will only obtain a degree from Chiba University.

### ◆ **Post Urban Living Innovation Education and Research Program/PULI Program**

This program focuses on the situations in Japan and Latin America to clarify the challenges faced by the world's urban areas, and will develop human resources in both countries who will contribute to living innovation in the future. The program is jointly run by Chiba University and five major Mexican universities: Universidad Panamericana (Mexico), Autonomous University of Aguascalientes (Mexico), University of Monterrey (Mexico), Tecnológico de Monterrey (Mexico), and Universidad Nacional Autónoma de México (Mexico). Students of particular excellence will be invited to Chiba University to study for a master's degree.

### ◆ **Campus Asia Plant Environment Innovation Program /CAPE Program**

This program is a joint educational program of plant environmental design integrating faculty of horticulture and engineering, and will address the expanding academic field that integrate the humanities and science. The program is jointly run by Chiba University and six major China and Korean universities: Tsinghua University (China), Zhejiang University (China), China Academy of Art (China), Nanjing University of the Arts (China), Guangzhou Academy of Fine Arts (China) and Yonsei University (Korea). Students of particular excellence will be invited to Chiba University to study for a master's degree. The program consists of the Double Degree Program, where students will obtain a degree each from the two universities, and the Degree Program where students will only obtain a degree from Chiba University.

- 2) The applicant is a personally-funded international student who is nominated by a sister university listed above.

Only those who fulfill the two conditions set forth above as well as one of the followings of (1) through (6) can apply for this program.

(However, at the time of application, those who are receiving a Japanese government (Monbukagakusho/MEXT) scholarship as international research students at the graduate level except undergraduate university students, or have successfully been selected as Japanese government (Monbukagakusho/MEXT) scholarship international students, or be candidates of MEXT scholarship international students (international research students at the graduate level, may apply for “Japanese Government/MEXT Scholarship International Students Special Selection”).)

- (1) They must have completed a 16-year program in the educational institutions in a foreign country, or expect to complete such a program by September 2022.
- (2) They must have completed a 16-year program in the educational institutions of a foreign country, or expect to complete such a course of study by September 2022, after taking a correspondence program offered by a foreign school in Japan.
- (3) They must have completed, or are expected to complete a foreign university curriculum by September 2022,

through which the applicant is certified as having completed 16 years of school education in the respective foreign country, at an educational facility in Japan that has been accredited as having a curriculum approved under the educational system of the respective foreign country and is so designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology of Japan (hereinafter referred to as “the Minister of MEXT”).

- (4) They must have been awarded, or are expected to be awarded a degree equivalent to a bachelor’s degree by September 2022, by completing a three-year or longer program at a foreign university or other foreign educational facility. The university or educational facility must have been accredited by the respective foreign government or a person certified by the appropriate foreign governmental agency, or have been so designated by the Minister of MEXT (This includes applicants who have completed an appropriate program offered by the respective foreign educational facility through distance learning while residing in Japan, and applicants who have completed an appropriate foreign educational program at an educational program at an educational facility in Japan as specified in the previous category.).
- (5) They must have completed a 15-year program in the educational institutions in a foreign country, or must have completed a 15-year program in the educational institutions of a foreign country after taking a correspondence program offered in Japan by a foreign school, by September 2022 and have been recognized by this graduate school as having obtained the prescribed number of credits with superior grades.
- (6) They must have been recognized to have scholastic attainments that are at least the equivalent of those of graduates of foreign universities, based on an examination, conducted by this graduate school, of the applicant’s qualifications to enter this school, and be also 22 years of age or be going to turn 22 by September 2022.

Applicants who would meet the Required Qualifications (5) or (6) above need another procedure in advance. Please see “4. Request for Judging Applicant’s Qualification to Take the Entrance Examination”.

Mailed applications must arrive before 17:00 by the same deadline as above.

Incomplete documents might be not accepted. When application is to be made directly from abroad, applicants are strongly advised to contact the Graduate Student Affairs Unit of the Student Affairs Division for Science and Engineering for confirmation of the applications well ahead of the application deadline.

- (4) Notification of Results  
Applicants will be notified of the decision whether to recognize their qualification by a simple registered mail or EMS.
- (5) Admission Application Procedures  
The applicants who are approved that they are qualified to take the entrance examination by this graduate school, still need to submit the rest of the admission application documents during the admission application period (see Section 3 and 4), though the documents already submitted in this recognition process are not necessary to be resubmitted for that.
- (6) Entrants Selection Process  
The admission's selection of the applicants approved in this recognition process is conducted in the same manner as general applicants.

## 5. Entrants Selection Process

- (1) Selection Method  
Applicants will be selected based on an examination (an oral interview) and academic transcripts.
- (2) Examination  
Oral interview: It will include a check in the basic scholastic ability and a research proposal and others.  
\*For applicants residing abroad, the examination date and place might be considered and then decided based on the advance consultation before the admission application. Please contact desired supervisor for more information.
- (3) Examination Date and Time  
Tue., August 16, 2022, 10:00 a.m.
- (4) Examination Location  
It will be held on Nishi-Chiba campus at Chiba University. Please confirm the notice posted on the bulletin board for more details. (See section 6-(1) below.)

## 6. Precautions

- (1) Necessary information about the examination and assignment of examination rooms will be posted on the bulletin board of the Faculty of Engineering (Faculty of Engineering Bldg. #10) at 10:00 a.m. the day before the examination.
- (2) Please be sure to bring and have your Admission Ticket for Examination with you during examination period.
- (3) On the entrance examination day, there happen to be some traders concerned with soliciting for notice of the exam results by telegram or the sales of goods at the nearby station or campus around. Those acts bear no relation to Chiba University. You must be careful not to be in troubled by being charged unreasonably for them. Chiba University will take no responsibility for it even if such an accident happens.

  - Admission Fee: JPY282,000 (once at matriculation)
  - Tuition Fee: JPY321,480 per semester (annual total tuition: JPY642,960)



#### Notes

- (a) Applicants of October Admission should pay the tuition for Fall semester in November by direct debit. The detailed information on the direct debit will be given at the time of the entrance procedure.
- (b) If the tuition or others be revised, the new tuition or others will go into effect as of the time of the revision.
- (c) There is a system by which the enrollment fee and tuition may be waived.

JPY3,260 for Type A (for 2 years), or

JPY20,130 for Type B (for 2 years)

#### 9. Completion Conditions

The standard residence period in the master’s program is two years. It is the necessary conditions to complete the master’s program that you must be registered for two years or more, and also take thirty credits or more which are provided by this graduate school, and besides, successfully pass inspection of the master’s thesis or the result of study on a specific subject, and the final examination.

#### 10. Early Completion

A student may shorten the period required to complete the master’s program to one year if the student has met the completion conditions in the program, and besides, achieved excellent research results while enrolled in the program.

Based on “the Foreign Exchange and Foreign Trade Act”, Chiba University established “the Security Export Control Regulations of National University Corporation Chiba University” and is conducting rigid examinations before accepting students.

Desired research activities may be restricted when they are applicable to the regulations.
