Research Ethics Education Requirement for Students Admitted in October 2025

In accordance with the *Guidelines for Responding to Misconduct in Research Activities* (established by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology/MEXT), Chiba University requires all researchers to complete research ethics education.

Graduate students admitted in October 2025 are also required to complete research ethics training via e-learning (APRIN).

Please register for the course on the APRIN website (https://edu.aprin.or.jp/), following the attached instructions. **Please complete the research ethics education (e-learning) after receiving your student ID card on October 1.

After completing the course, please submit your certificate of completion along with your "Course Plan" to your academic advisor.

**Students entering the doctoral program must retake the course, even if they completed it during their master's program.

Important: Students who do not complete the training will not be permitted to register for the compulsory courses "Graduate Research I & II."
