

To newly enrolled students to the Graduate School of Science and Engineering

Research Ethics Education (e-learning)

Chiba University provides the Research Ethics Education for researchers according to “Guidelines for Responding to Misconduct in Research (adopted by Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology/MEXT)”.

And besides, all the graduate students as being equivalent to the researchers are required to take the Research Ethics Education (e-learning).

Therefore, take the course of APRIN e-learning program as below.

(The new doctoral students who already took the course when being as the master’s students, must still take the course once again.)

In addition, those students who do not take the course are not allowed to take the compulsory subject “Graduate Research I and II” (called “Tokubetsu Kenkyu I and II”).

How to:

1. Go to the APRIN’s website. (<https://edu.aprin.or.jp/>)
2. View the User’s Manual.
3. Log in.
4. ID: “CU Student ID code”
(e.g. Your current Student ID code: 24WM0000 → Your log-in ID (username): CU24WM0000)
5. PW: “CU#Student ID code”
(e.g. Your current Student ID code: 24WM0000 → Your PW: CU#24wm0000)
* You can change the password after logging in.
6. Change to an email address currently available when dummy address is set by default.
7. Take the required course below.
 - 【融合理工学府（理学系）】全学共通倫理教育 2024 (Research ethics education course_2024)
 - 【融合理工学府（理学系）】理工学研究領域の論文発表とピア・レビュー／Ethical Issues in the Peer Review and Publication of Engineering Research
8. After completing the course, get a CCR (Course Completion Report) issued.
9. Submit BOTH forms below together to YOUR ACADEMIC ADVISOR, not to us at the Graduate Student Affairs Unit.

 - Course Plan of Graduate School of Science and Engineering (called *Rishu Keikaku-sho*)
