

Measures for Entrance Examinations for Master's and Doctoral Programs to Graduate School of Science and Engineering against COVID-19/Coronavirus Infection

At the moment, foreign nationals who are currently staying in many countries outside Japan might be subject to denial of landing due to the spread of coronavirus infection (COVID-19). Regarding TOEFL/TOEIC L&R test scores as admission application materials, some types of online tests may be held in addition to the regular TOEFL/TOEIC L&R ones. Therefore, we have decided to deal with the graduate school entrance examinations as below.

And besides, we will plan to conform to the following way for the admission application in and after November 2021 and the entrance examinations depending on the future situation.

Overseas candidates*

who are currently staying in one of the specified countries/regions written in the notifications, "Regarding denial of landing to prevent the spread of COVID-19 (novel Coronavirus)" announced by the Japan Ministry of Justice as of May 25, 2021 (See the latest version on the webpages.) and "Measures of denial of landing to prevent the spread of COVID-19 (novel Coronavirus) and status of resuming cross-border travel (Overview)" as of May 19, 2021. [1] Admission Application and Selection Method for *Overseas Candidates**

- i) When you cannot expect to enter Japan at the time of the entrance exams:

We have decided to deal with the graduate school entrance examinations as below for those entrance exam-takers who cannot expect to enter Japan, and to allow them to take an online interview as per their request. If anyone would like to take an online interview, he/she must notify so to his/her future academic advisor of each department in advance of submitting admission application materials.

【 Master's Programs Admissions / General Selections 】

Admissions: October 2021 and April 2022

Application period: June 22-24, 2021

The overseas candidates may be handled as below.

- Both an official score report or certificate of TOEFL or TOEIC L&R and its photocopy must be submitted

us with other required application material before the application deadlines.

(Candidates to the department of Environmental Remote Sensing, and of Imaging Sciences must also submit us the one before the application deadlines.)

- Candidates to the department of Environmental Remote Sensing, of Urban Environment Systems, and of Imaging Sciences that were originally scheduled to take an oral interview in person as the entrance examination in August, are now required to take an online interview on Tuesday, August 17, 2021.
- Candidates to other departments may be screened and selected through an online interview taken on the specified date in the table below.

The overseas candidates are required to take an online interview.

【 Doctoral Programs Admissions / General Selections 】

Admissions: October 2021 and April 2022

Application period: June 22-24, 2021

The overseas candidates are required to take an online interview.

ii) When you enter Japan to take the entrance exams at the time of the entrance exams:

Everyone entering Japan including graduate school entrance exam-takers is required to refer to the latest notifications of each government ministry and agency and related webpages, and besides, to self-isolate for a period of 14 days (required number of days based on the latest notification) after entering Japan. They cannot take a written test as the entrance exams during the self-isolation though they can take an online interview.

➤ According to the notification, “*Measures of denial of landing to prevent the spread of COVID-19 (novel Coronavirus) and status of resuming cross-border travel (Overview)*” announced by the Japan Ministry of Justice as of May 19, 2021, the Japanese government is implementing entry restrictions to Japan for some other countries/regions in addition to the specified ones to denial of permission to enter Japan at the moment. However, when the entry restrictions are eased at the time of conducting the entrance exams, you must check the latest information on the below webpage of each ministry by yourself, and besides, self-isolate for a period of 14 days after entering Japan.

[3] Reissue of the TOEIC-IP Score Certificate Held at CU/Chiba University for the Candidates to the Graduate School of Science and Engineering in 2020

When some applicants of the test-takers of TOEIC-IP conducted on CU Nishi-Chiba Campus on Saturday, July 18, 2020, who applied for October 2020/April 2021 Admissions, the master’s program/General Selections to the

Graduate School of Science and Engineering, would like to reissue the TOEIC-IP score certificate to submit for the admission application to the graduate school 2021, they need to follow the below procedures.

[Reissue application]

Deadline: Friday, June 11, 2021, 17:00

Location: the office in charge (Science/Engineering fields)

Application form: It is received at the office above.

What to bring:

1. Student ID, Driver's license, Health insurance card or other
2. Japan postal money order of the amount of 550 JPY
3. Name seal (called *inkan/hanko*) of the applicant
