

Special Measures Taken as Response to COVID-19 for
Privately Financed International Students Selection of Master's Program to
Chiba University Graduate School of Science and Engineering (Science Fields)
April 2022 Admission

[1] Admission Selection Method for Overseas Candidates※

We have decided that we approve of their taking an online examination using internet connection in their country of residence when applicants currently staying outside Japan who plan to take an entrance examination of the Privately Financed International Students Selection to the Graduate School, cannot come to take the entrance examination in Japan.

However, that only applies to meet all the conditions below:

- _ They must satisfy Required Qualifications of application for the Privately Financed International Students Selection to the Graduate School.
- _ All application materials without error must arrive to the university during the application period.
- _ They must have a stable internet connection.
- _ They must inform us all the items as stated below by email by Thursday, November 4, 2021.

※ *who are currently staying in one of the specified countries/regions written in the notifications, "Regarding denial of landing to prevent the spread of COVID-19 (novel Coronavirus)" announced by the Japan Ministry of Justice as of August 24, 2021 (See the latest version on the webpages.) and "Measures of denial of landing to prevent the spread of COVID-19 (novel Coronavirus) and status of resuming cross-border travel (Overview)" as of August 24, 2021. ※ Everyone entering Japan including graduate school entrance exam-takers is required to refer to the latest notifications of each government ministry and agency and related webpages, and besides, to self-isolate for a period of 14 days (required number of days based on the latest notification) after entering Japan.
